You are going to see these three dates everywhere, but let me further explain them here:

- 1) Sunday night, March 29th at 5:00 pm is a unique opportunity that hopefully turns into tradition. All churches in Waco have been invited to participate in an evangelistic Easter pep-rally at McLane Stadium. If you come you'll get a chance to see the gorgeous McLane stadium up close, you'll get a chance to hear a phenomenal preacher in Tony Evans, and you'll get a chance to hear an 800 person choir that will include the CBBC choir. - 2) The second day of hope is our annual Thursday night Tenebrae service on April 2nd at 7:30 pm at Chalk Bluff. This is an intimate and dark service accentuated by our choir and the Lord's Supper that point to the crucifixion. This is a gem of our church that many miss each year, please do not let that happen this year.
- 3) The final day of redemption is our Easter Sunday services that are always filled with life and hope. Sunday, April 5th we will gather together in 2 services (8:30 & 11:00) to celebrate the resurrected Lord.

As a member of our church you need to make a commitment to attend all 3 of these services. There will be great power in these 3 days that you do not want to miss. Go ahead and mark on your calendar that these 3 days are non-negotiable. They are set aside for your Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.


